Rewards and sanctions

Our full Behaviour and anti-bullying policies are available on our website. This includes an outline of behaviour awards and key sanctions. In addition to this, we operate a red card system at lunch time. Anti-social behaviour at lunchtimes will result in the child missing outside plays or going home for lunch the following day. If it happens again, parents will be asked to talk to a senior member of staff. If things don't improve, the child will have to go home for lunch permanently.

In addition to this, teachers nominate children to be entered in the Golden Book This is for a whole range of achievements relating to their efforts in learning and learning behaviours.

Good attendance is rewarded through stickers for individual children.

Regular absences and lateness will be followed up by a visit from our Education Welfare Officer.

To help us keep a really effective working environment and to avoid problems over loss or breakages, we discourage the bringing of toys to school. Mobile phones and electronic devices will not be allowed at all. If any toys, mobiles or devices are brought into school, a member of staff will remove them. The item will only be returned to the child's parent/carer. Parents who require their child to carry a phone for use outside of school may arrange this with the school office, where the phone must be kept during the school day and collected at the end of the day. We accept no responsibility for these devices.
