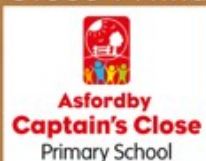

Headteacher Update

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you are all well. As we move further into the term, I wanted to share some updates from across the school, along with a new feature in this weeks newsletter based on recent pupil feedback in years 3-6.

Anti-Bullying Relaunch—As part of their feedback, children expressed a wish for us to keep revisiting themes around friendships and kindness. We are therefore relaunching our anti-bullying focus this term—not because of an increase in concerns, but to continue supporting children in understanding:

the difference between friendship fallouts and bullying

how to manage disagreements positively

when and how to seek help

what bullying truly means, so the term is not used incorrectly

This reflects our commitment to ensuring playtimes remain positive and that all children feel safe, understood, and supported.

Whole-School Playground Redesign Project—We are excited to share that during our Thursday Crew Assemblies, we have launched a whole-school project to redesign our playground spaces.

The children will be:

identifying how our outdoor areas can be more purposeful and active

sharing ideas for physical play, calm spaces, creativity and exploration

shaping what their future playtimes could look like

Over the coming weeks, we will update you on their designs and thinking.

We would love to hear from any parents who have:

experience or passion for outdoor design,

gardening expertise, or

an interest in helping develop our forest school area.

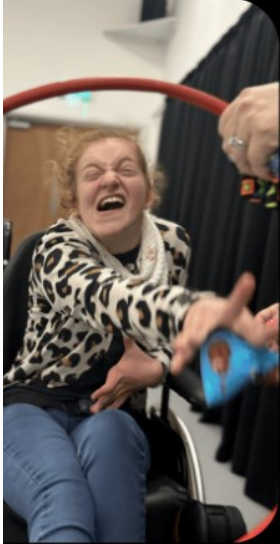

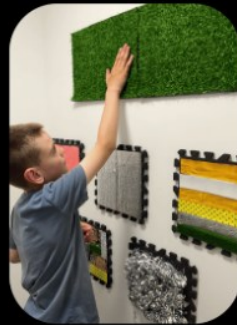
