



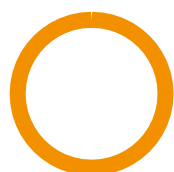

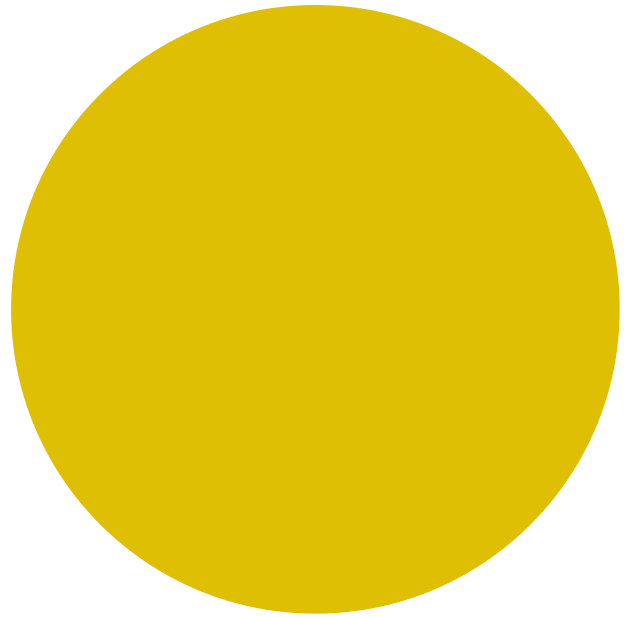
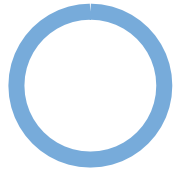

Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE)

At Captains Close Preschool, we are committed to providing high-quality early education to all children.

We offer FEEE, which helps cover the cost of preschool education for eligible children. This funding ensures that every child has access to enriching educational experiences, regardless of their family's financial situation.

Families can apply for funding through their local council, and our team is here to assist you with the application process

All 3 and 4 year olds - all families	15 free hours per week	over 38 weeks
All 3 and 4 year olds - eligible working families	30 free hours per week	over 38 weeks



Our Fees



Although government funding is a great way to help with childcare expenses, it only extends to a restricted number of hours and does not cover all costs.

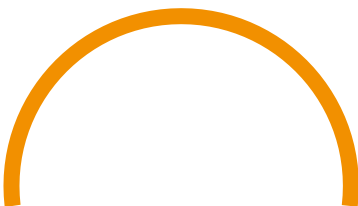
All fees must be paid in advance, monthly, as outlined in the Pre School contract. We offer support through Early Years Funding, which can help cover the cost of preschool education. Our team is here to assist you in understanding and applying for this funding, making the process as smooth as possible.

Working out the weekly cost

If you have 15 or 30 hours of Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE) you can use them to cover the cost of your Pre-School care. We also accept workplace vouchers and the government Tax Free Childcare Scheme.

You could choose to spread the FEEE across the week: 3 x hours per day, for 5 days. Morning Session Time: 8.45-11.45 or Afternoon Session Time: 12.15-3.15pm

You could also use your free hours to cover the 6.5 hour day.

All hours over and above your child's FEEE will be charged at £5.88

If you would like your child to do a full day or a half day and add on a lunchtime, you can either provide a packed lunch for your child or book them a school dinner at a cost of £2.89.

Please speak to the Pre-School Manager, or the school office and they can help you with booking a visit and securing your child's pre-school place.





Workplace Childcare Vouchers

We accept workplace vouchers from the companies listed, to help pay for your child's Preschool fees. If your workplace voucher company is not listed, please contact us and we can register as a user.



Simply allocate an amount to the voucher and the voucher company will send it directly to us.

Additionally, we participate in the Tax-Free Childcare scheme, a government initiative that provides up to £500 every three months (up to £2,000 a year) for each child to help with childcare costs. For children with disabilities, this amount increases to £1,000 every three months (up to £4,000 a year)

Please note: to qualify for these vouchers you must have joined a workplace childcare voucher scheme on or before 4th October 2018.
