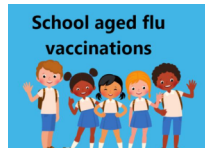

## Upcoming School Trips

Dear Parents and Carers,

Firstly, we would like to extend our sincere thanks to those of you who have contributed towards recent school trips. Your support is greatly appreciated and plays a vital role in enabling us to offer enriching experiences for our children.

However, we must be honest about the challenges we are facing. The school funding for many schools is very challenging and budget is tight. From an administrative point of view, it is extremely time-consuming for office staff to chase outstanding payments. We are doing our best to support families by sending out letters and booking trips well in advance to allow as much time as possible for payments to be made. Please can we ask parents and carers to read communications carefully to see upcoming events and speak to us if you would like support or assistance to stagger payment costs.

To make the recent Year 5 and Year 6 trips possible, we have had to draw on a £100 donation per trip from FOACC which was originally intended to support future trips. In addition, the remaining shortfall—£475 across both trips—has been covered using Pupil Premium funding. This is not a sustainable solution. On this occasion we can confirm y5 construction trip and y6 WW2 trip will go ahead—the payment item on Arbor is still open for further contributions.

The school is already subsidising a significant number of costs. For example, we have fully funded all swimming lessons this year and only asked for contributions towards transport. Unfortunately, due to our rural location, we rely heavily on transport to access facilities, which increases costs compared to schools in more urban areas.

Looking ahead, we want to be transparent: we will not be able to continue supporting trips in this way. Without sufficient parental contributions, this may risk future trips being cancelled. This means children will miss out on valuable learning opportunities and experiences that enhance their education and personal development.

We understand that financial pressures are affecting many families, and we are grateful for any support you can give. Together, we can ensure our children continue to benefit from the broad and balanced curriculum they deserve.

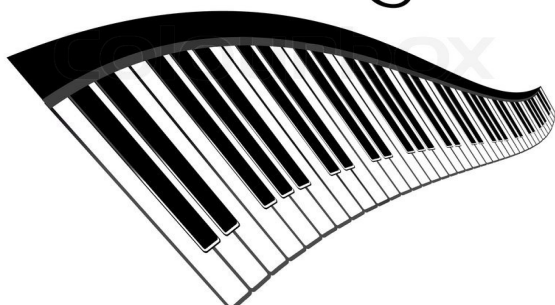
